

Return to School After Illness

What if my child is experiencing COVID-like symptoms?

COVID-19 Symptoms:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

Stay home.

Call your child's doctor.

Call school office.

Attend classes online via ACS Distance Learning, IF physically able.

Fever free without fever reducing medication for 72 hours

Symptoms improving

10 days since the symptoms first appeared

Stay home.

Call your child's doctor.

Call school office.

Attend classes online via ACS Distance Learning.

Get tested.

Complete self-quarantine for 14 days without symptoms from last exposure.

BEFORE returning to school, call the school office to confirm all required procedures have been followed.

What if my child had known high-risk exposure to a laboratory confirmed positive COVID-19 case?

What if my child tests positive for COVID-19?

Stay home.

Call school office.
